# FDI, OUTSOURCING GOING UP! OFFSHORE-OUTSOURCING AND FOREIGN DI-RECT INVESTMENT (FDI) - LED TO AN IN-




# **TARIFFS GOING DOWN!**

ASIAN ECONOMIES, IN PARTICULAR, HAVE RELA-TIVELY LOW APPLIED TARIFFS ON IMPORTS (ESPECIALLY ON SEMI-PROCESSED GOODS).

GRESS REQUIRES:



- **INFORMATION CAMPAIGNS** TO RAISE AWARENESS. INTERNATIONAL AND NATIONAL CO-OPERATION NEED-ED TO EXCHANGE VIEWS AND BEST PRACTICES, AND ORGANIZE METHODOLOGICAL WORKSHOPS (MIWI).
- INTEGRATING STATISTICAL DATA "SILOS" (I.E. BUSI-NESS, TRADE, FINANCE AND EMPLOYMENT) TO EQUIP DECISION-MAKERS TO MAKE INFORMED DECISIONS ON TRADE POLICY. (ITS VISION).





OF US 2009 TRADE BALANCE IN IPHONES IS ATTRIBUTED TO CHINA WHEN USING THE VALUE ADDED METH-OD. USING THE TRADITIONAL WAY, 100% of the balance would HAVE BEEN COMPLETELY ATTRIBUTED TO CHINA.



TRADE IN COMMERCIAL SERVICES SHORT-TERM INDICATORS Now Available

#### 10% INCREASE IN EXPORTS ESTIMATED IN 1ST QUARTER OF 2011

A NEW PROJECT ON SHORT-TERM TRADE IN SERVICES STATISTICS IS CURRENTLY BEING DEVELOPED. QUARTERLY ESTIMATES WILL BE RELEASED AFTER THE SUM-MER BREAK, INCLUDING DATA BY COUNTRY. LATEST FIGURES FROM 53 REPORT-ING COUNTRIES ACCOUNTING FOR ABOUT 78 PER CENT OF WORLD TRADE SHOW 1ST QUARTER 2011 EXPORTS TO HAVE A 10% GROWTH AS COMPARED TO THE SAME QUARTER IN 2010.


