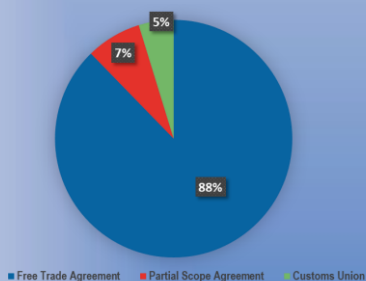
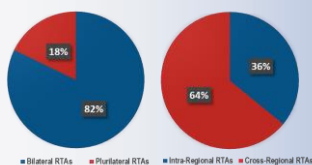

## STATE OF PLAY AS OF 30 JUNE 2023

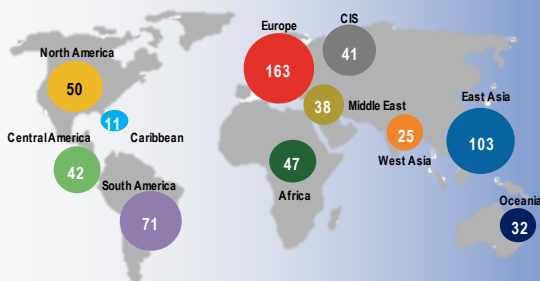

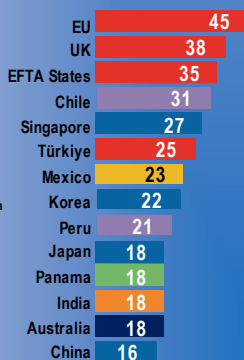
