Stuart Harbinson represented Hong Kong (and the HK Special Administrative Region of China) at the WTO for eight years from 1994 to 2002, in which capacity he also chaired some of the WTO's key Councils (including the TRIPS Council), Committees and negotiating groups. He subsequently became Chief of Staff and, later, Special Adviser to the Director-General of the WTO, and then Senior Adviser to the Secretary General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development. Based in Geneva, after working for international law firms, he is now a Senior Consultant on International Trade for the global communications agency Hume Brophy. He is a Fellow of the Asia Global Institute and the European Centre for International Political Economy (Brussels) and has also chaired a number of WTO dispute settlement panels.
